5th Annual Edible Book Festival at the Spring Book Fair



This is a family project, AND it's not for a grade!

An edible book is created out of something you can eat, and it looks like a book or makes reference to a book title or character.

1. Each edible creation must depict a fiction or non-fiction work or character.
2. Each food creation must be at least 80% edible. (made of foodstuff)
3. Creations should not require refrigeration, as they will be on display. Therefore, it must not be made of extremely perishable ingredients.
4. The base can be no larger than 18 x 12 inches.
5. Each creation must be accompanied by a sign (4x6 index card) which includes the title of the book and your family name on the back.
5. One entry per student. Entries must be family friendly.
6. Entries will be judged on the following criteria: (a) Originality (b) Creativity (c) Visual appeal (c) Tie-in with the literary work (d) Followed directions
7. Two \$20 Book Fair gift certificates will be awarded to the top two creations. Winners will be announced Thursday morning.
8. Your edible creation must be set-up in the St. Anne Catholic School Library on Tuesday, April 19, between 7:30 am and 3:30 pm.
9. Edible books will be on display from April 19 - 22. Unclaimed creations will be tossed on Friday, April 22, at noon.
10. The International Edible Book Festival is held every year on April 1. More information on other edible book contests and sample creations may be found on, but not limited to, the following websites:
